Biography

Matt is a musical comedian based in London and Manchester, where he is the Director of Programming at Manchester-based comedy production company Channel K, whilst his varied experience also includes stints as narrator for Bravo!, producer and director of hit BBC One observational documentary *Bailiffs*, journalist on *Plymouth Sound Radio* and *Daily Star* writer discussing sex and relationships for the *Daily Star*.

Previously at the Edinburgh Fringe Matt performed the well-received show, *Soft Toys* in 2003, which was followed by his 2005 show, *Ladykiller*. By 2008, after playing just a few small gigs as a musical act, he had earned audience and critical acclaim during performances at the UK's leading comedy festivals, including Manchester, Bath and Leicester.
